September

Open events and applications open.

November onwards

Complete your application form. Visit our website and click on 'Apply Now' or 'Sixth Form Admissions'. The application form requires information including contact details as well as your preferred subject choices.

November

Attend your consultation evening appointment. As part of this, we invite you and your family to attend a consultation evening to discuss your subject choices and offer advice and guidance. It is not an interview.

December onwards

Following your consultation evening appointment we will send you a conditional offer letter.

May to June

GCSE exam season!

July

Attend our Sixth Form Induction to meet your new teachers, your new classmates and start your academic studies.

August

GCSE Results Day! Once you know your grades, we will confirm your subject choices. If you don't meet the entry requirements we can offer other courses, subject to availability.

September

Before you start your academic studies, we help you settle in by completing our enrolment programme.

We encourage all students attending Shireland CBSO Academy to study at least one Level 3 music qualification and two additional A Level/BTEC courses. If you choose not to study a music qualification, we will expect you to support and contribute to our music ethos.

We consider students wishing to study four A Levels or equivalent qualifications on a case-by-case basis.
